BOARD SELF EVALUATION
(previously in Policy 9)

BACKGROUND

The purpose of the Board self-evaluation process is to allow for constructive dialogue and feedback. This process will confirm the Board’s commitment to, and congruence with, the Strategic Plan and its Guiding Principles as well as its adherence to Policy Governance.

1. EVALUATION TIMEFRAME

- 1.1. The annual Board self-evaluation process will complement the Director of Education evaluation process.
- 1.2. The Chair of the Board will solicit responses from trustees at the end of the school year and report at the final June meeting.

2. EVALUATION CRITERIA

- 2.1. Some examples of questions that the Board may consider:
 - 2.1.1. How well have we fulfilled each of our defined roles in relation to our mission, goals, and objectives as a Board this year?
 - 2.1.2. How well have we adhered to our annual work plan?
 - 2.1.3. How well have we adhered to our governance policies?
