ATHLETIC ASSOCIATIONS

BACKGROUND

The district recognizes that participation in athletics is an important curricular and co-curricular activity for students.

PROCEDURE

1. The principal of each school may develop both intramural and inter-school athletic competitions as deemed appropriate by the principal, in consultation with staff and students.
2. The organization and administration of the elementary and secondary inter-school athletic program is the responsibility of the school principal, assisted by the Renfrew County Elementary Intramural Athletic Association(s) (RCEIAA - East & West) and Madawaska Elementary Activity Association (MESAA) or the Upper Ottawa Valley High School Athletic Association (UOVHSAA).
3. Each principal of a secondary school shall, in accordance with a district plan to provide for co-instructional activities, develop and implement a school plan providing for co-instructional activities.
