- English with Core French beginning in grade 1

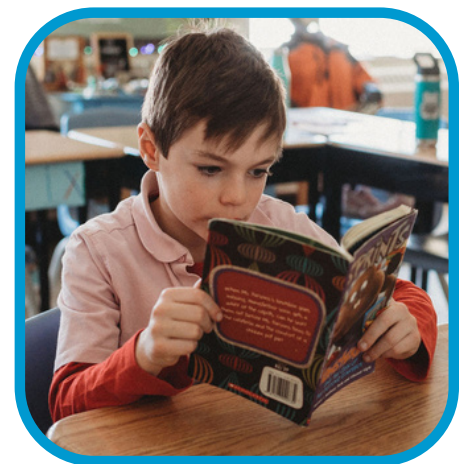
