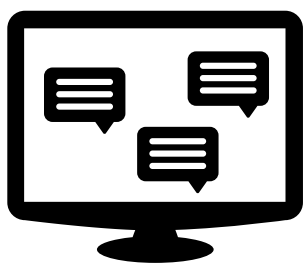
Earn hours by helping at home or on a school day
