

Ontario Minister of Education Announces Online Education Resources Portal in Support of Continued Learning During the COVID-19 School Closure

March 20, 2020 – This afternoon, the Ontario Minister of Education announced a “Learn at Home” program designed to assist Ontario students with continued learning throughout the COVID-19 two week school closure period.

The program uses an online portal to provide students with interactive learning tools designed according to the Ontario K-12 curriculum. Additional educational programming will be available through the TVO and TFO channels.

‘Learn at Home’ will provide math and literacy resources created by Ontario-certified educators, in both English and French. Elementary content is aimed at helping young students learn using interactive activities, while high school content is designed with a focus on STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) courses. Bilingual materials on Learn at Home will be added on a regular basis to provide new content throughout this period. Other learning programs, such as Ontario’s Virtual Learning Environment, are being further developed to provide enhanced learning options.
